Flight Bangkok to Yangon

- Suggested flight – Friday, 10 May 2019 depart 1345 arrive Yangon, Myanmar 1435

Flight Yangon to Bangkok

- Suggested flight – Wednesday, 15 May 2019 depart 1520 arrive Bangkok 1720

PLEASE NOTE: if you are connecting to an international flight on Wed, 15th May you MUST ensure that your flight departs AFTER 2000 (8:00pm) to ensure you have time to collect luggage and re-check in.

Currency: Local currency is Burmese kyat and USD is widely accepted.

Clothing and temperature:

You will be travelling during the hot season, temperatures reach into the mid 30's and higher. Baggy lightweight clothes are essential along with a hat, a small umbrella and a fair amount of sun cream.

Woman must not wear revealing clothing showing of body or skin, therefore sarongs and pashminas are a must to pack. Shoulders and knees must be covered when visiting religious sites. Men must wear shorts that fall below the knee, or they can wear a sarong over their shorts when visiting religious sites.

It is best to wear footwear that can be slipped on and off easily, as you will be removing footwear when visiting religious sites. Sturdy lightweight comfortable walking shoes also a must to pack.
