He is the Professor of Transplantation, University of Oxford and an Honorary Consultant Surgeon at Oxford Universities Hospitals NHS Foundation Trust; he is also Director of the Oxford Transplant Centre and Fellow of Green Templeton College. He is a specialist in organ transplantation and hepatobiliary surgery. He is author of more than 200 scientific papers. He is a member of the Council of the Royal College of Surgeons and also of the International Transplantation Society. He is a past-president of the British Transplantation Society. He is one of the co-founders of OrganOx, a spin-out company from the University of Oxford, established to develop novel ways to preserve and repair donor transplant organs.*
